# Independence

freedom to act independently

Idea

- promote a culture of autonomy
- Fail fast, fail forward

# Confidentiality

Protection of sensitive information

Ideas

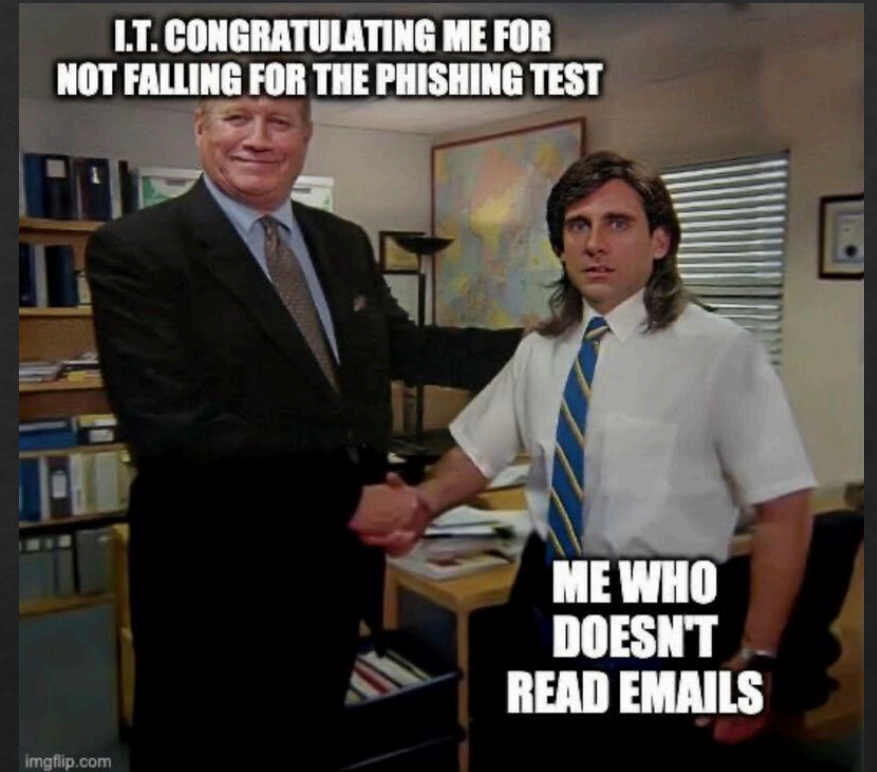
- strong encryption mechanisms
- restricting access to authorized personnel only

# Human centered approach

consider the needs and behaviors of individuals

## Ideas

- user-focused training sessions
- People management skills e.g. empathy





# Empowerment

the necessary resources, knowledge, and authority

Ideas

- specialized training programs
- certifications



# Equal opportunity

opportunities for are available to individuals from diverse backgrounds

## Ideas

- actively recruiting individuals from underrepresented groups
- providing mentorship programs

# Accountability

Holding security champions accountable for their actions

## Ideas

- Establishing metrics and performance
- Feedback from dev teams

# Accessibility

cybersecurity resources and knowledge easily accessible to all individuals

## Ideas

- Developing user-friendly tools and interfaces
- providing clear and concise documentation
- offering support channels for questions and assistance
